Progress Report

Progress reports will be available for parents via Aladdin Connect today Thursday June 16th. In your child's report the teacher will have provided feedback on many areas including:

- Your child as a learner
- Your child's social and personal development
- Your child's learning across the curriculum
- Ways that you can further support your child's learning

The reports for Rang I - Rang VI will also show the results of the standardised tests in Maths, English Reading and Spelling.

The Department of Education as per circular 18/2021 acknowledges that Covid-19 have had a significant impact on teaching and learning which may be reflected in the standardised test results. It is important that parents keep this in mind. Like all other tests, a child's performance on any given day can be affected by a range of factors. Whether a score is high or low, one score will not necessarily confirm a child's achievement level and a child's score may naturally fluctuate from year to year. I have attached some information for parents on standardised tests which may be helpful in understanding your child's report.
